President Peter opened the meeting and welcomed all Rotarians, including Goolwa Rotary Club President Maxine Timbs who was accompanied by a large contingent from the club, and Maxine Timbs, President of the Rotary Club of Victor Harbor. Also in attendance was Linda Sweeney from Seaford club who is Assistant Governor Area 11. Our Guest Speakers Tim Mee and Maurice O'Connell from the New Dawn – Rotary Ukraine Project were also welcomed by President Peter.

Earlier this week the Victor Harbor High School held its annual presentations and our club was represented by President Peter and Colin Francis, Director of Youth Service. The Rotary Club of Encounter Bay continued its long tradition of donating the cash academic prizes which were presented by Peter and Colin. President Peter reported that it was a very successful and rewarding evening.

President Peter then handed over to David Virgin, Director of International Service as Chairman for the evening. David introduced Tim Mee, New Dawn – Rotary – Ukraine Crisis projects; Chair of District 951- International Service, & District Governor Nominee (2024-25); and Maurice O'Connell, who, although not a Rotarian, shares Rotary's values and has many Rotarian friends.

When Russia invaded Ukraine, Maurice decided to travel there as a volunteer to help those civilians impacted by Russia's aggression. He connected with some Ukrainian volunteers who had formed the non-government organization "New Dawn" to help the forgotten villages with food, electricity, clean water and other basic supplies they had been living without following extensive destruction of their villages.

The organization has developed to now being well financed from the initial group of Ukrainians who pioneered it.

Maurice explained that 2,167 medical buildings have been destroyed by the Russians, and providing medical and education facilities are priorities.

Initially just forgotten villages, they have now succeeded in delivering support and children are able to go back to school, although with the front line so close they must frequently take shelter from the bombing. These bomb shelters were built especially by "New Dawn" volunteers.

Tim told us about the many projects that had been completed that helped local villagers, including providing 40 large windows in the local hospital, rebuilding a community centre and providing educational supplies.

It is a very upsetting and distressing story that Maurice and Tim shared with us all last evening, but inspiring to learn about their outstanding contribution to humanitarian aid and support for Ukraine.

Chairman David thanked them on behalf of us all for coming down from Adelaide to explain to us the amazing work they continue to do.
